

HOUSE OF ASPAZIJA

House of the prominent Latvian poetress Aspazija in Dubulti is one of the most beautiful museums in Jūrmala. The special atmosphere of the House of Aspazija is created by music, art and history; the restored exhibition of the museum helps experience the spirit of the last century, via not only early 20th century household items and interiors, but also projected holograms and interactive educational games. Take a short walk along the narrow street Aspazijas iela that leads to the beach and take a picture with the sculpture "Aspazija in the dunes"!



JŪRMALA OPEN-AIR MUSEUM

The Jūrmala Open Air Museum is located in Buļļuciems, nearby the Ragakāpa Nature Park, and is the largest museum in Jūrmala. The museum reveals a typical coastal fisherman's household from to the end of the 19th and the beginning of the 20th century - a fishnet hutch, a dwelling house, a barn, a fish smokehouse, bathing hut. The museum has an extensive collection of anchors and fishing boats, as well as Latvia's richest collection of tools and materials for wreathing ropes.

The museum is proud of its exhibition about fishery boat constructing, revealing the authentic unfinished wooden boat and ancient construction devices.

The Dubulti Railway Station was built in 1977, and, according to the idea of its architect Igor Javein, it created associations with the rolling sea.

BULDURI EXHIBITION HOUSE

Bulduri Exhibition House was built in 1920-ies and embodies the essence of the best traditions of the Jūrmala wooden architecture.

The two exhibition halls and an outdoor area are completely devoted to art, innovative and creative processes – exhibition halls host art exhibitions and visitor engaging art actions, creating an art space as an important stop for anyone seeking a creativity.

On the 2nd floor of the exhibition hall the visitors can explore the workroom and the paintings of the excellent master of the landscapes Valdis Bušs (1924–2014).



ĶEMERI WATER TOWER

Ķemeri Water Tower is a part of the historical industrial heritage of Latvia. After reconstruction in 2021 the 42-meter high Water Tower, preserving its main function, attracts visitors with expositions about the history of Kemeri resort as well as with spectacular views opening from the two panoramic platforms.

The Water Tower is located in the historical Kemeri resort park, which is the oldest and largest public garden in Latvia outside Rīga. The landscape park with small architecture forms, mineral water springs and sculptures is beautiful in any season.
